

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE 25: YORK QUAY REVITALIZATION UNDERGROUND GARAGE

This morning we have started with the demolition of the concrete secant wall that was constructed to form the hole that the parking garage has been built in. It is important that this portion of the secant wall be removed as if it were to remain it would have a negative impact on restoration of the site.

This work will result in more noise than what has been experienced recently and some minimal vibration may be felt by some at times because of the nature of this work. Our intention is to perform this work only during regular week day hours, between as a general rule 7:00 AM and 5:30 PM. If there becomes a need to perform some of this work outside of these hours a notice will be issued prior to that work commencing. Vibration levels will be monitored and if necessary formal measurements will be taken to ensure that levels do not exceed the applicable standards. We expect this work to be ongoing for most of January.

Every effort will be made to eliminate any needless noise through this operation as the happiness of the surrounding neighborhood is of the utmost importance to us. We would like to once again thank all neighbors for their understanding and cooperation through this construction process.

We do understand that this activity may concern some residents and apologize for that inconvenience.
