**RE: IMPORTANT NOTICE - Underground Construction
- Project Rees Street - X12525**

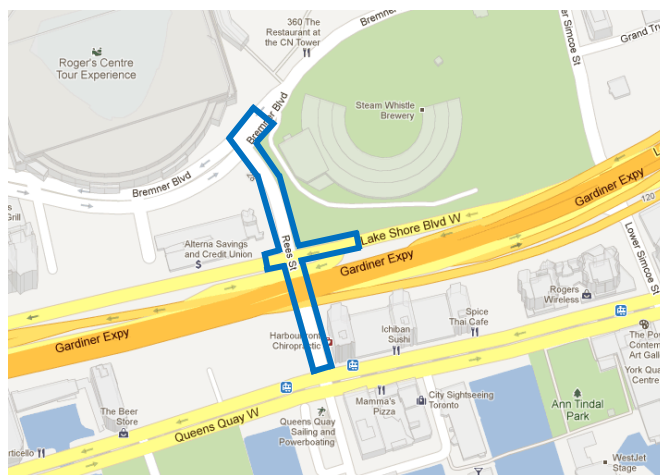
Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited (Toronto Hydro) is in the process of upgrading the electrical system in Toronto's downtown core. **We will be constructing underground ducts and cable chambers.** This project will improve the capacity and flexibility of the electrical system along Rees Street and allow for the future development of the proposed Bremner Transformer Station, Queens Quay West and Toronto Waterfront.

Construction work is expected to **start during the week of October 17th 2011 and is anticipated to be completed by mid-February 2012.** The affected streets of Project Rees Street are: Rees Street, Bremner Boulevard, and Lake Shore Boulevard West (please see map).

The scope of work includes open trenching, tunnel excavation, the installation of new cable chambers and concrete encased ducts. To control ground water, well points will be installed.

All construction work for Project Rees Street will take place within the City of Toronto's property. Parking lanes will be used by our crews which will reduce traffic to single lanes in each direction. Crews will be working Monday to Friday, with road crossings on the weekend. All work specifically on Lake Shore Boulevard West will be expedited into the evenings and seven days a week until the work on Lake Shore Boulevard West is completed.

No planned power interruptions will be required to complete this project.



Our contractor, Entera Utility Contractors, and Toronto Hydro Inspectors are sensitive to local concerns and will work to minimize disruptions to local residents. Toronto Hydro's contractor will temporarily restore our area of work. The City of Toronto will make permanent restoration as season, weather and scheduling permits.
